In the afternoon workshop session, engineers will be requested to:

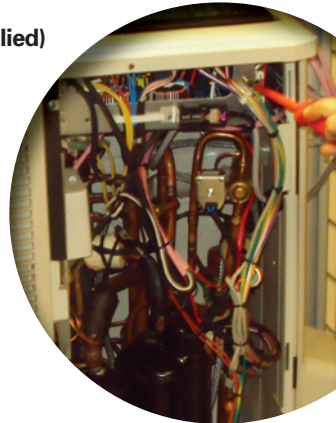
- **Connect indoor and outdoor units together (flexible lines supplied)**
